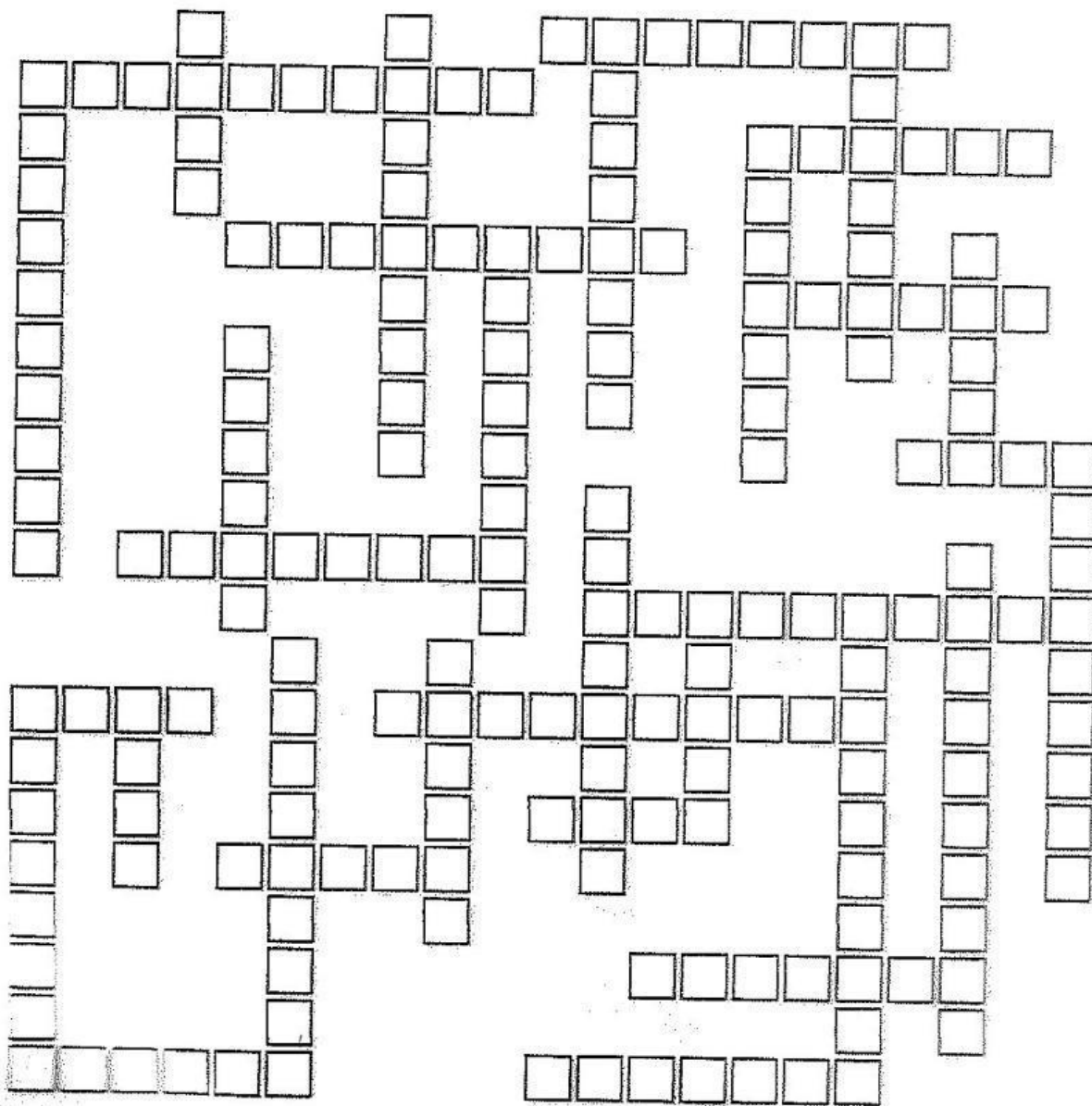


ROAD TEST
