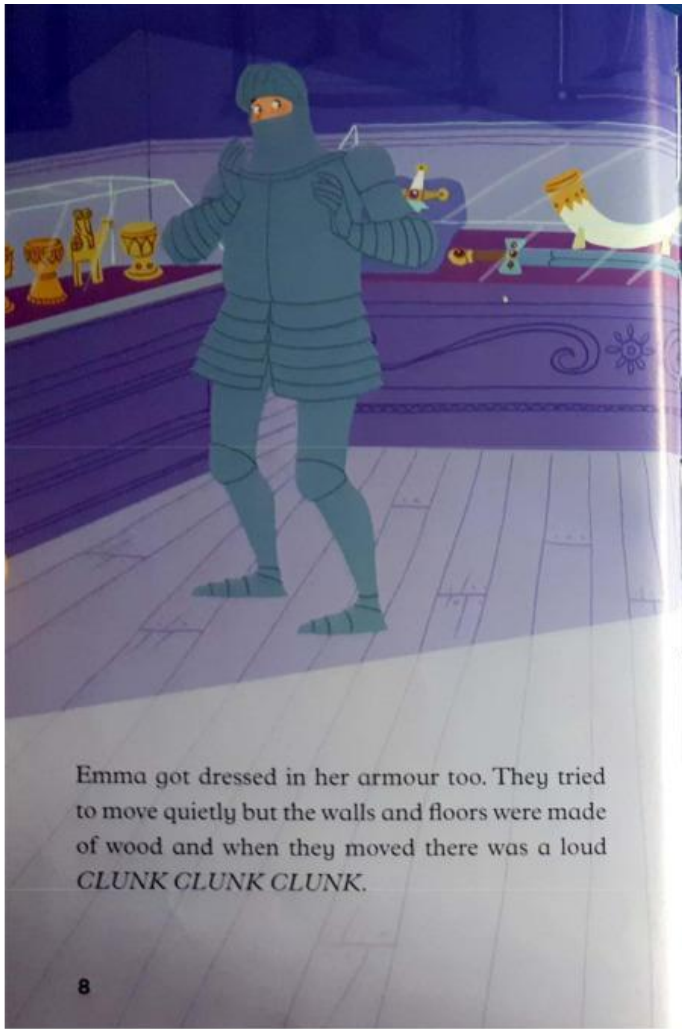


Emma helped Harry to get dressed. Harry's ring got caught on a metal vest. 'Ouch! Stop pulling!' said Harry.

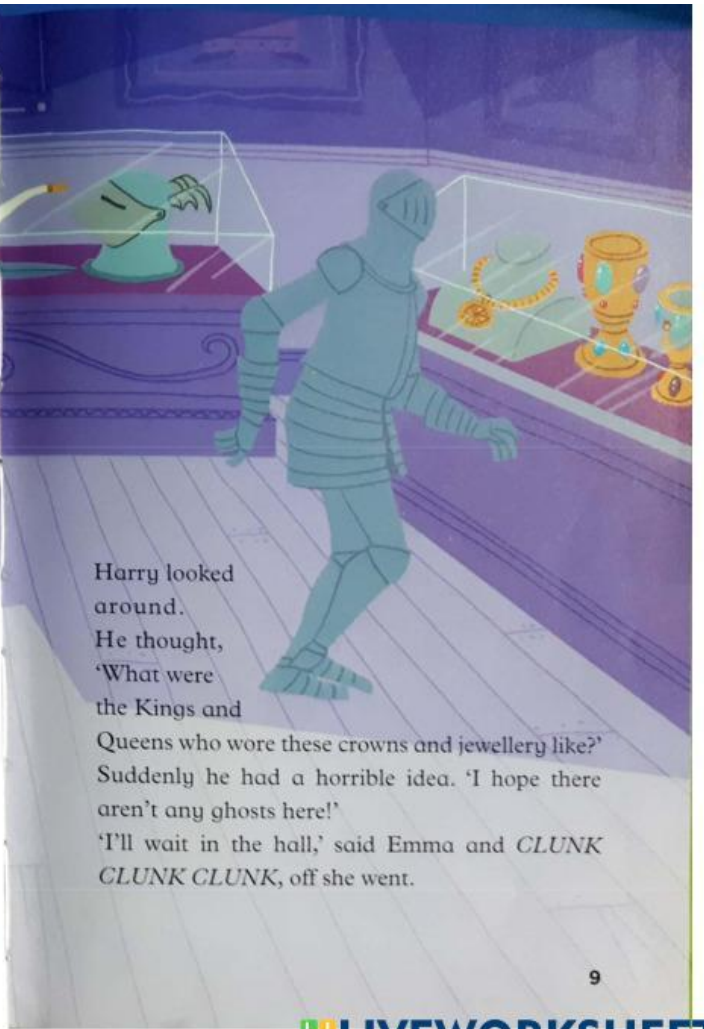
'Oh! O.K. Sorry!' said Emma.

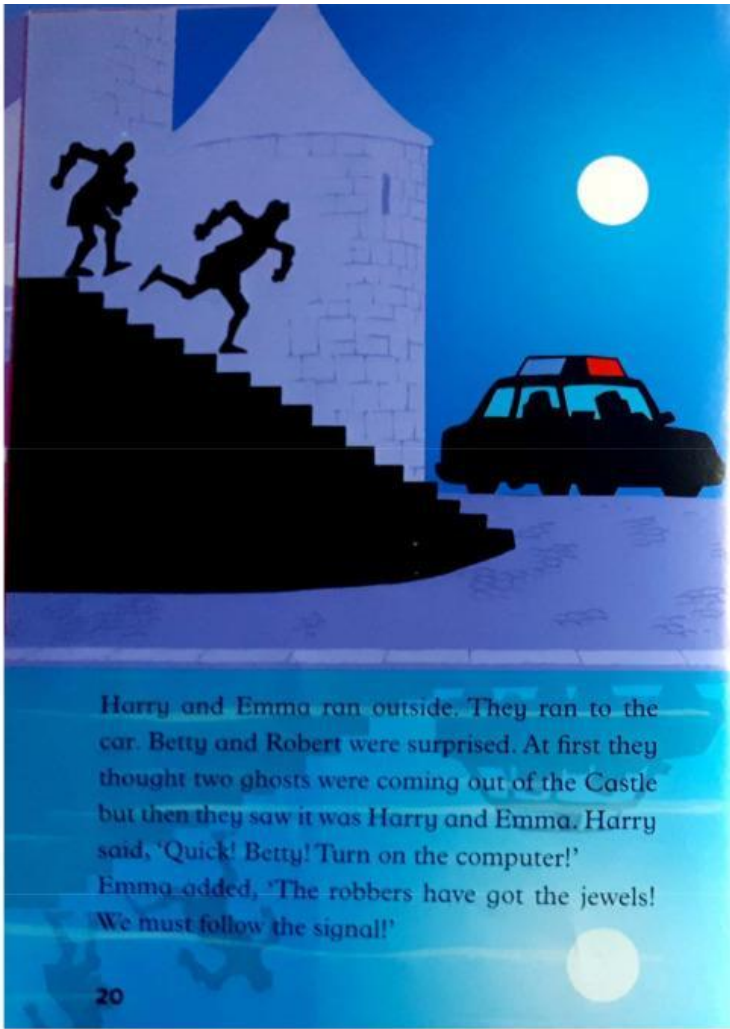


Emma was horrified! She didn't have any jewels! Her mouth opened and she looked at Harry. Finally she said, 'What jewels? What are you talking about?'
