
Tweetbot allows you to customize your Twitter experience. You can mute people without unfollowing them and you can still stay on top of all the activity on Twitter.

### WHALE SHARK DIVES 6,000 FEET UNDER



Whale sharks, known as the gentle giants, are the (0) ..... fish alive today. Not so long ago, scientists believed they (28) ..... a lot about them, but recently, this huge fish revealed a big secret: they can dive deeper than ever suspected before.

Scientists used a satellite tag on the sharks' fins so they could observe and record their dives.
