<p>AND is used to join words or ideas together.</p> <p>John has a dog and a cat.</p>	<p>BUT is to joining two contrasting words or ideas.</p> <p>It is my birthday, but I'm not having a party</p>	<p>BECAUSE used to give reasons.</p> <p>I have to study because I want to go to university.</p>
<p>SO is used to show results.</p> <p>I was sick, so I stayed in bed.</p>	<p>YET is used to express extreme contrast.</p> <p>It is raining, yet there are lots of people at the beach</p>	<p>FOR is, like because, used to give reasons.</p> <p>I studied a lot in the last week, for I have a test tomorrow.</p>
<p>OR is used to talk about choices or alternatives.</p> <p>I don't like cooking or washing the dishes.</p>	<p>NOR is used to negate the second part of two negative sentences.</p> <p>My neighbor is not nice, nor do I like him.</p>
