Televizyon izliyordum (**o anda**). Aslında **2 saattir** televizyon izlemekteydim/izliyordum.

* I had been watching tv **since 8 p.m.** = You left home at 8 p.m. So, I had been watching tv **since you left**.

Saat 8'den beri televizyon izliyorum. = Sen 8'de evden ayrıldın. **Sen gittiğinden beri** televizyon izliyorum.

Tomorrow at 3 p.m. I will be studying (**An**) Yarın **saat 3'te** çalışıyor olacağım.

Tomorrow at 3 p.m. I will have been studying for 2 hours (I started studying at 1 p.m.) (**Süreç**) Yarın saat 3'te **2 saattir** çalışmakta/çalışıyor olacağım.
