


Present Continuous



Listen and repeat.

Two frogs are standing by,
Two butterflies are flying high,
and to the frogs they're saying goodbye.
He's singing, she's dancing,
they're running, they're jumping,
they're playing in the sun,
they're having fun.



Affirmative		Negative	
Long form	Short Form	Long form	Short Form
I am walking	I'm walking	I am not walking	I'm not walking
You are walking	You're walking	You are not walking	You aren't walking
He is walking	He's walking	He is not walking	He isn't walking
She is walking	She's walking	She is not walking	She isn't walking
It is walking	It's walking	It is not walking	It isn't walking
We are walking	We're walking	We are not walking	We aren't walking
You are walking	You're walking	You are not walking	You aren't walking
They are walking	They're walking	They are not walking	They aren't walking

Spelling rules

work – working, read – reading, climb – climbing, fly – flying

BUT: cut – cutting, put – putting, write – writing, dance – dancing

We use the **present continuous** for actions happening now. He is sleeping now.
