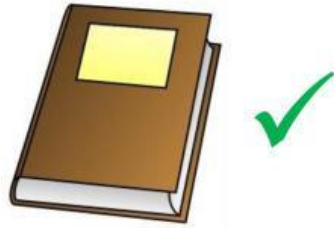

You haven't got a rubber **but** you've got a pencil.



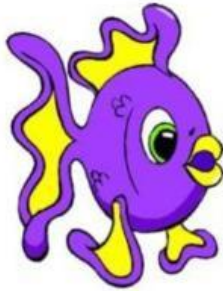
Katie

Katie's got a laptop **but** she hasn't got headphones.



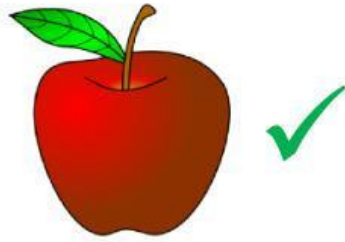

Kim and Phil haven't got a fish **and** they haven't got a horse.



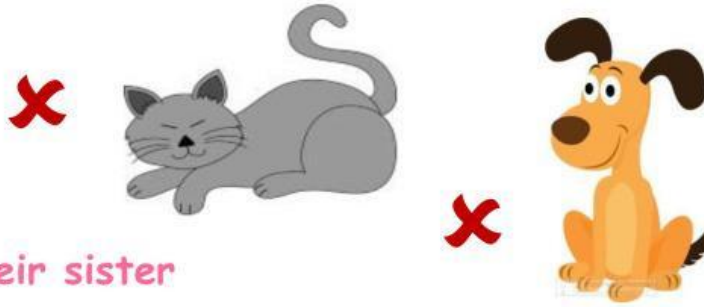
the hamster

Their sister hasn't got a cat **and** she hasn't got a dog.



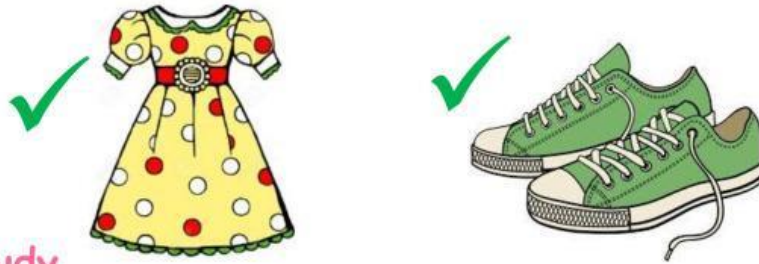
Monica

Tracy's got a bike **and** she's got a horse.



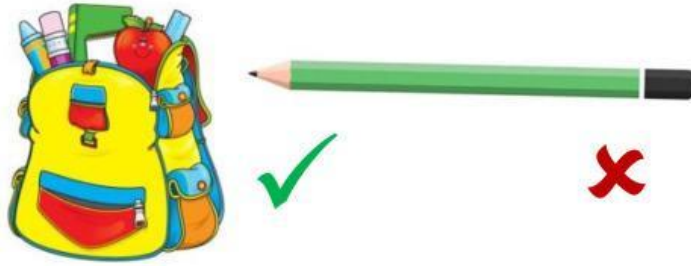
Jack's mother
