ZEBRAS



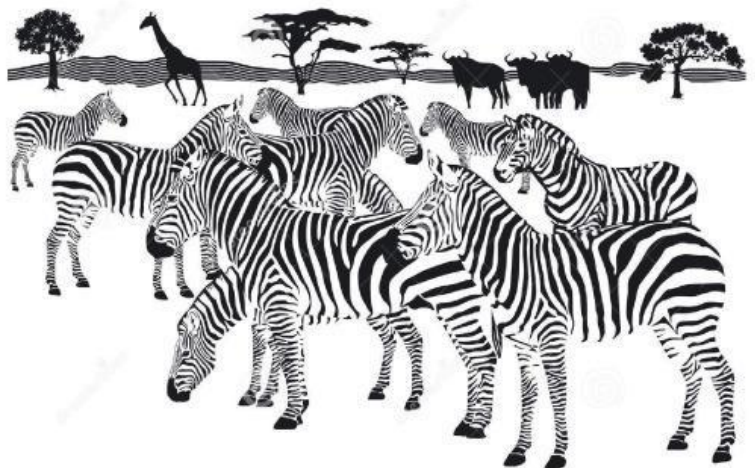
Zebras have common features , they have black and white stripes, each zebra has a different pattern of stripes.

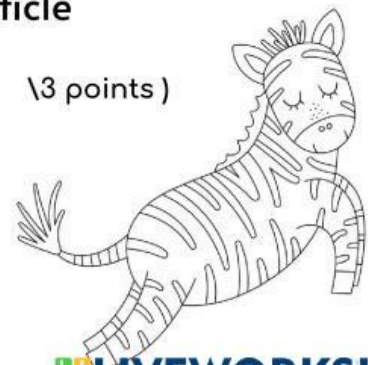
