Bearded Dragon

Most Bearded Dragon species (21) from the dry parts of Australia. They are generally (22) and peaceful reptiles which makes them good pets for both kids and adults. Bearded Dragon requires specific supplies which includes an appropriate (23), special lights, and suitable accessories.

Bearded Dragons are (24), requiring both plant and animal-based foods as part of their diet. Young Bearded Dragons need protein to fuel their growth. Dust veggies or crickets with a little calcium (25) can help its bone develop. They stay hydrated from what they eat, so making sure they have a sufficient supply of food is important. Other ways to keep them hydrated is by using a spray bottle and keeping a (26) water dish.

Other than that, to be healthy and happy, Bearded Dragons need a lot of heat and full-spectrum (27) – just as they'd get in their natural habitat. The best temperature for the basking area should be about 90 – 100 (28) Fahrenheit.

Caution! You should take them outside twice or thrice a week. When placing a Bearded Dragon in aquarium, exposure to sunlight is not a (29) for natural light. Window glass (30) out the sunlight so Bearded Dragons will not receive the right amount of light that they need if they are outside.
