MY SUMMER: AN ADVENTURE WITH MY FAMILY

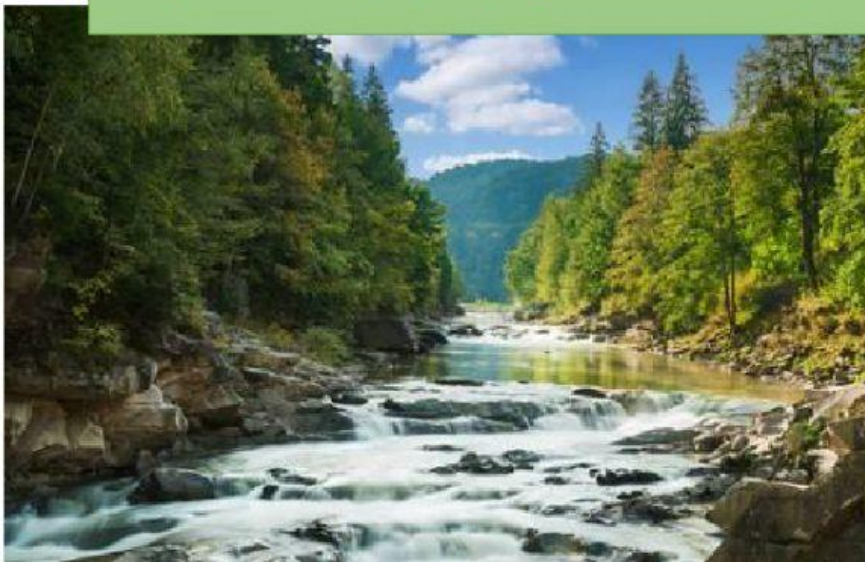
