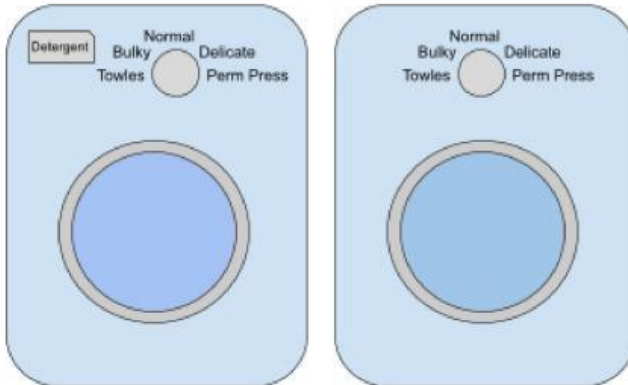


1. Circle the dryer:
