The **University of Melbourne** is a public **research** university located in Melbourne, Australia. It is Australia's second1 (old) university and also known by its motto *Postera crescam laude* "Later I shall grow by praise". It2 (become) one of Australia's six members of the Group of Eight in the 19th century.

Out of the total 42182 students in the University, around 12000 are international students. The University is well known for its high standards of education, teaching, and research and3 (offer) a wide range of undergraduate and **postgraduate** programs. The main **campus** of the university in Melbourne is located in Parkville. The university also has several other campuses located across Victoria. The main campus of the University in Acton has seven teaching and research **colleges**, besides several national academies and institutes. The university4 (comprise) ten separate academic units and is associated with numerous institutes and research centers.

There5 (be) fifteen graduate schools, including the Melbourne Business School, the Melbourne Law School and the Melbourne Medical School. *Times Higher Education* 6 (**rank**) the University of Melbourne first in Australia and 32nd globally in 2019 because Eight Nobel Laureates gained the **distinction** of being prestigious researchers at this university. What's more, four Australian prime ministers and five governors-general graduated from the University of Melbourne.
