A Style of Scottish Music which mixes traditional music with Modern instruments such as Electric Guitars and Drumkits.	A form that has an A section which repeats throughout the piece. E.g. ABACADA	The melody is immediately copied in another part.	An unaccompanied Scottish folk song sung by male farm workers.	When a bass part moves on every beat.
