Grammar Box: Comparative and superlative adjectives

We use comparative and superlative adjectives to make comparisons between things.

Comparative adjectives compare one thing with another.

e.g. *Madrid is big.*

Bangkok is bigger.

We usually make comparisons with *than*.

e.g. *Bangkok is bigger than Madrid.*

Superlative adjectives compare one thing with several others (more than two).

We use *the* before the superlative adjective.

e.g. *Trento is the smallest city.*
