

Convert fractions to decimals

Example

1) Convert $3/8$ to a decimal.

We calculate $3 \div 8 = 0.375$

So we now have,

$$3/8 = 3 \div 8 = 0.375$$

Example 2)

Convert $9/20$ to a decimal.

We calculate $9 \div 20 = 0.45$

So we now have,

$$9/20 = 9 \div 20 = 0.45$$
