wink (verb)	to open and close one eye quickly; an action that usually shows affection or indicates a secret; blink
freckles (noun)	brown spots on the skin, usually in sun exposed areas; mole
magnificent (adjective)	beautiful, extravagant, spectacular, impressive, excellent
accompany (verb)	to take, go with or escort someone somewhere
trailing (verb)	to follow something or someone using something, such as smell or marks, that was left behind
bustling (verb)	to move in a quick way; dash, hurry, scurry, hustle
cautious (adjective)	careful to stay away from bad things; watchful, attentive
