

### Definitions

<b>wink</b> (verb)	to open and close one eye quickly; an action that usually shows affection or indicates a secret; blink
<b>freckles</b> (noun)	brown spots on the skin, usually in sun exposed areas; mole
<b>magnificent</b> (adjective)	beautiful, extravagant, spectacular, impressive, excellent
<b>accompany</b> (verb)	to take, go with or escort someone somewhere
<b>trailing</b> (verb)	to follow something or someone using something, such as smell or marks, that was left behind
<b>bustling</b> (verb)	to move in a quick way; dash, hurry, scurry, hustle
<b>cautious</b> (adjective)	careful to stay away from bad things; watchful, attentive
