Andrew and Alex suggested that the fishermen use their nets to remove the plastic. But the fishermen said, 'We don't get paid to collect plastic; we get paid to catch fish.' The surfers saw a big problem and decided to do something. Their idea was the 4Ocean bracelet.

Each bracelet that is sold helps to provide money to support a team of ocean cleaners. Since the company started, over 150 people have joined 4Ocean to work in many countries around the world. 4Ocean's first goal is to remove a million pounds of trash from the ocean and coasts. If you want to help, you can buy a bracelet and you can also work as a volunteer.

There's too much plastic in the ocean and it's a big problem. However, if people work together by using less plastic and developing new ideas like the 4Ocean bracelet, then maybe we can really help save our oceans..
