PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE:



Song: "What a Wonderful World" by Louis Armstrong

Target: Present simple verbs to describe things in the world ("I see trees of green, red roses too...")

PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE:



Song: "Walking on Sunshine" by Katrina and the Waves

Target: Continuous action verbs ("I'm walking on sunshine, whoa!")

PAST SIMPLE TENSE:



Song: "Yesterday" by The Beatles

Target: Regular and irregular past tense verbs ("Yesterday, all my troubles seemed so far away...")

FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE:



Song: "Tomorrow" from the musical "Annie"

Target: Will + base verb for future predictions ("Tomorrow, tomorrow, I love ya tomorrow...")

PRESENT PERFECT TENSE:



Song: "I've Got a Feeling" by The Black Eyed Peas

Target: Present perfect tense ("I've got a feeling that tonight's gonna be a good night...")

COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES:



Song: "Bigger" by Justin Bieber

Target: Comparative and superlative forms ("You got me feeling so much better, better, better...")

MODAL VERBS:



Song: "Lean On Me" by Bill Withers

Target: Can, should, could ("Lean on me when you're not strong...")

GERUNDS AND INFINITIVES:



Song: "I Want to Hold Your Hand" by The Beatles

Target: Infinitives ("I want to hold your hand...")

CONDITIONAL SENTENCES:



Song: "If I Were a Boy" by Beyoncé

Target: Second conditional ("If I were a boy, even just for a day...")
