



# SONGS FOR GRAMMAR TARGETS

## PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song:** "What a Wonderful World" by Louis Armstrong

**Target:** Present simple verbs to describe things in the world ("I see trees of green, red roses too...")

## PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE:



**Song:** "Walking on Sunshine" by Katrina and the Waves

**Target:** Continuous action verbs ("I'm walking on sunshine, whoa!")

## PAST SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song:** "Yesterday" by The Beatles

**Target:** Regular and irregular past tense verbs ("Yesterday, all my troubles seemed so far away...")

## FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE:



**Song:** "Tomorrow" from the musical "Annie"

**Target:** Will + base verb for future predictions ("Tomorrow, tomorrow, I love ya tomorrow...")

## PRESENT PERFECT TENSE:



**Song:** "I've Got a Feeling" by The Black Eyed Peas

**Target:** Present perfect tense ("I've got a feeling that tonight's gonna be a good night...")

## COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES:



**Song:** "Bigger" by Justin Bieber

**Target:** Comparative and superlative forms ("You got me feeling so much better, better, better...")

## MODAL VERBS:



**Song:** "Lean On Me" by Bill Withers

**Target:** Can, should, could ("Lean on me when you're not strong...")

## GERUNDS AND INFINITIVES:



**Song:** "I Want to Hold Your Hand" by The Beatles

**Target:** Infinitives ("I want to hold your hand...")

## CONDITIONAL SENTENCES:



**Song:** "If I Were a Boy" by Beyoncé

**Target:** Second conditional ("If I were a boy, even just for a day...")
