# FUTURE PROGRESSIVE

STRUCTURE	DEFINITION	EXAMPLE
<b>AFFIRMATIVE</b>	Subject + will be + present participle	<i>She will be studying at the library tomorrow.</i>
<b>NEGATIVE</b>	Subject + will not (won't) be + present participle	<i>They won't be attending the meeting next week.</i>
<b>INTERROGATIVE</b>	Will + subject + be + present participle?	<i>Will you be coming to the party later tonight?</i>
<b>USE</b>	Describes ongoing actions that will happen at a specific time in the future.	<i>They will be traveling to Europe next summer.</i>
<b>TIME EXPRESSIONS</b>	At this time tomorrow, next week, by this time next month, by the end of the year, etc.	<i>She will be finishing her project by next Friday.</i>
