

# CONDITIONALS

## ZERO

*It is used to talk about truth and facts in the present.*

**Main clause      If-clause**

**Present Simple      Present Simple**

**Water turns into ice if the temperature falls below zero.**

## FIRST

*It is used to talk about real or possible things in the future*

**Main clause      If-clause**

**Future Simple      Present Simple**

**He will paint the fence If you buy some paint.**
