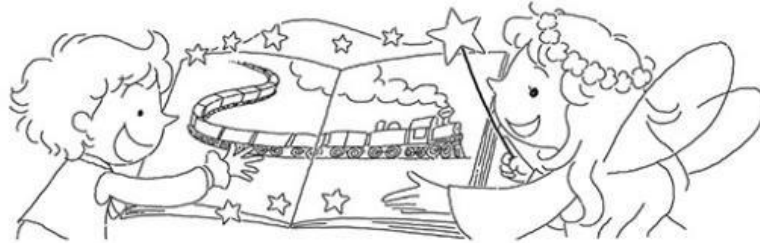
1 One day in Whiteland ...

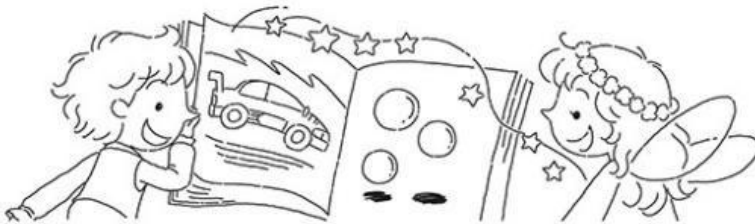


F: Don't be sad. Look at this book. It is very colourful.
