What is "Kwanzaa"?

Kwanzaa is a holiday that celebrates African culture and lasts seven days, from December 26th to January 1st each year. Over five million Americans celebrate this holiday, and they are joined by ten million participants worldwide. The holiday is relatively new as it was created in 1966 by Maulana Karenga, in the State of Long Beach. It appeals to many people for their dedication to the seven principles of unity:

self-determination, collective work and responsibility, cooperative economics, purpose, creativity, and faith. With all of those positive ideas, it is likely that so many families celebrate Kwanzaa, which means "first fruits of the harvest" in Swahili, an east African language.

Maulana Karenga said he wanted to "give Blacks an alternative to the existing holiday and give Blacks an opportunity to celebrate themselves and history, rather than simply imitate the practice of the dominant society." Kwanzaa is a celebration that has its roots in the black nationalist movement of the 1960s, and was established as a means to help African Americans reconnect with their African cultural and historical heritage by uniting in meditation and study of African traditions and *Nguzu Saba*, the "seven principles of African Heritage" which Karenga said "is a communitarian African philosophy".
