SECURE YOUR ONLINE PASSWORDS

The use of online payment services is becoming increasingly popular among consumers nowadays. Online payment is a quick and easy process. However, you need to take measures to protect yourself when making online transactions.

It is widely recommended that you should never use the same password twice. Many people use the same login and password for various websites. If a hacker gains access to a website, they will have your username and password for several sites. However, a lot of people struggle with remembering passwords, and occasionally they lose track of their most recent ones. One way to solve this problem is to use different versions of the same topic. You can, for example, use passwords that are all the names of countries you have visited, or your favorite books or films. You can also make a password more secure by adding numbers or capital letters.

More advice is to avoid writing down passwords on paper or on mobile devices. This certainly makes sense. But if you find it too difficult to remember all your passwords without writing them down, learn how to **disguise** them. Adding a few numbers in front, after, or even in the middle of passwords can help to secure them from other people. Following some of the simple tips above can help you protect your accounts and avoid the risks of making online payments.
