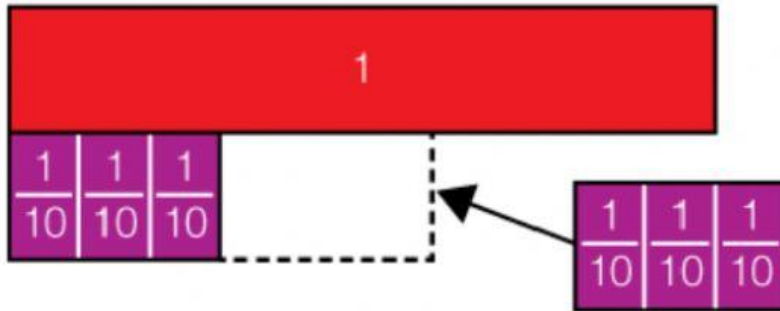


1) What addition problem is represented by the fraction strips?



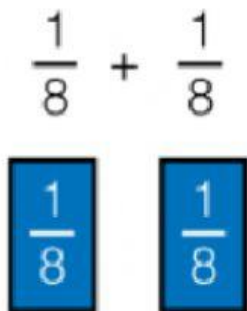

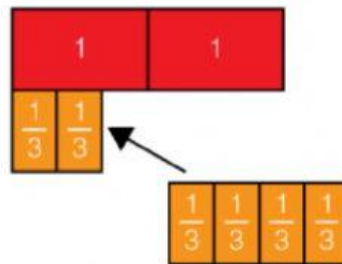
