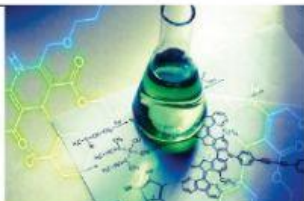

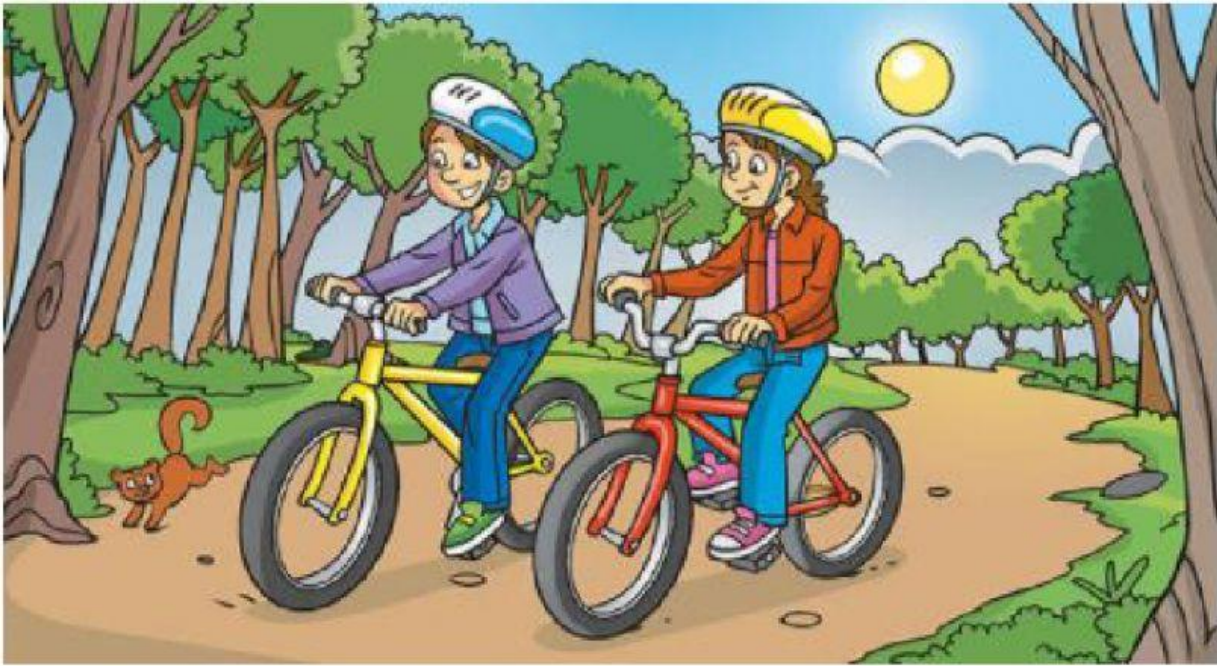
Clean bikes, dirty bikes ...
