On utilise one, another, some et some more dans des cas différents.

Il y a 2 variables :

- Ce dont on parle → est-ce un dénombrable ou indénombrable ?
- Veut-on parler d'un autre ou pas ?

	On parle d'une chose	On parle de rapporter un nouvel exemplaire de cette chose
Noms dénombrables SINGULIER	<b>one</b> ( <i>un, une</i> )	<b>another</b> ( <i>un autre</i> )
Noms indénombrables OU noms pluriels	<b>some</b> ( <i>du, de la...</i> )	<b>some more</b> ( <i>en</i> )
