5. Giving first aid- Accidents and emergencies

- **Bite:** A wound made by the teeth of an animal or person.
- **Bleeding:** Loss of blood.
- **Burn:** An injury caused by fire or touching something that is hot.
- **Choking:** Being unable to breathe because something is lodged in your throat.
- **First aid:** Emergency treatment immediately following an accident, before the emergency services arrive.
- **First aider:** A person who has been trained to give first aid treatment.
- **First aid kit:** A box containing first aid supplies and equipment which can be used to treat someone who has been injured in an emergency.
- **Fractured:** A broken bone.
- **Hazards:** Dangers or possible dangers.
- **Injury:** Physical damage to the body caused by an accident.
- **Minor accident:** An accident which does not cause serious injuries.
- **Mouth to mouth:** Giving oxygen by mouth to a person who is not breathing, to keep it alive.
- **Poison:** A toxic substance that is hazardous to live. Poisons can be inhaled, swallowed, or absorbed through the skin.
- **Pulse:** Heartbeat.
- **Stroke:** A medical emergency cause by lack of flow of blood to the brain.
- **Vomiting:** Being sick (throwing up).
