

# The use of 'bring', 'take', and 'fetch'

Examples: My mother **takes** me to the market.

Please **bring** me my glasses.

Do you have to **fetch** your sister from school?

The above words 'takes', 'bring' and 'fetch' are verbs. The use of these verbs depends on the place from which the action is viewed.

**'Take'** is away from the place.

**'Bring'** is towards the place.

**'Fetch'** is away and back to the place.
