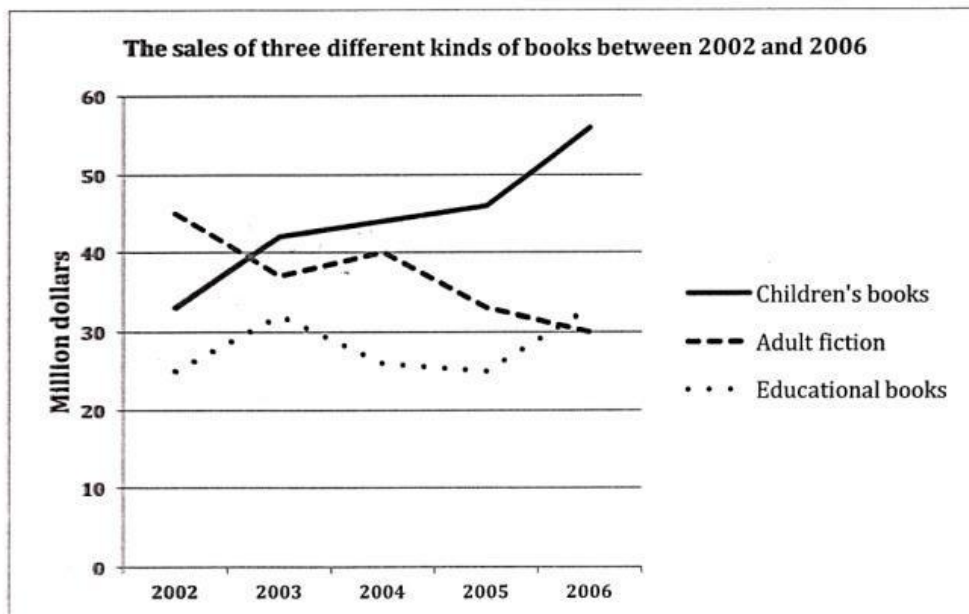


### Graph description (Introduction/ Overview/ Comparison/ Trends)



The line graph illustrates information about how **much/ many** money was earned from three kinds of books, **included/ including** children's book, adult fiction, and educational books over a four-year period from 2002 to 2006.

Similarly, as **for/ with** educational books, their figure witnessed a **substantial/ substantially** jump **of/ by** 10m dollars to just over 30m dollars in 2003, **following/ followed by** a decline to 25m dollars over the next two **year/ years**. **Consequently/ Subsequently**, it experienced an upward trend to just above 30m dollars in 2006.

**In/ On** contrast, as **regard/ regards** adult fiction, **despite/ in spite** a slight **recovered/ recovery** in 2004, its sales went down **constant/constantly** to 30m dollars in 2006.
