Noun

They are words that usually modify—that is, they limit or restrict the meaning of—verbs. They may also modify adjectives, other adverbs, phrases, or even entire sentences.

Verb

They describe or modify—that is, they limit or restrict the meaning of—nouns and pronouns.

Adjective

They are words that refer to a thing, a person, an animal, a place, a quality, an idea, or an action.

Adverb

They are words that show an action (*sing*), occurrence (*develop*), or state of being (*exist*).
