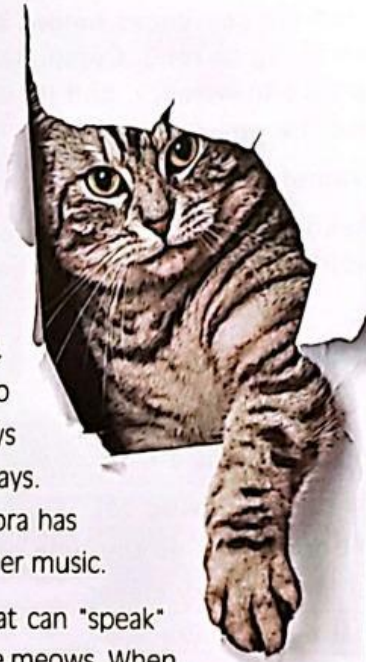


To Cats, WITH LOVE
