

Group 1

Example: Charlotte **refused** to make a cake.

1. My boss **decided** (give) me a promotion.
2. The teacher **demanded** (know) who was responsible for the mess.
3. We **agreed** (keep) quiet and not tell anyone the news.

or

We **agreed that** (keep) quiet.

4. We **threatened** (go) to the police.

Group 2

Example: Charlotte **reminded** her mum to make a cake.

1. They **asked me** (cook) for the guests.
2. He **begged his friend** (not, tell)
3. They **warned me** (not, go) there by myself.
4. The government has **ordered everybody** (stay) at home.
5. Her parents always **encourage her** (work) hard.
6. They **persuaded me** (stay) for another drink.
7. The doctor **advised me** (stop, eat) fast food so often.
8. Our new neighbours have **invited us** (have) dinner with them tomorrow.

Group 3 (geround)

Example: They denied **taking** the last biscuit.

(or)

They denied that they had **taken** the last biscuit.

1. She **admitted**(steal) the money.

(or)

She **admitted that she** (steal) the money.

2. She **suggested** (take) a taxi because it would be quicker.

(or)

She **suggested that we** (took) a taxi.

3. I **recommend** (go) in the morning when the weather isn't so hot.

(or)

I **recommend (that) we** (go) in the morning.

Group 4 (with a preposition)

Example: She **accused her friend of stealing** her jacket.

5. He **apologised for** (break) the window.

6. She is **thinking about** (move) to France.

7. He **insisted on** (pay) for everybody.

8. They **complained about** (not, have) a big hotel room.

or

9. They **complained that they** (not, have) a bigger room.

Imperatives:

Example: Mother to daughter: "Put on your shoes."

Mother told her daughter to put on her shoes.

1. The teacher to me: "Open your books."

The teacher told me

2. Coach to Jack: "Get on your feet!"

.....

3. The cashier to me: "Give me your receipt."

.....

4. The officer to us: "Do not park here."

.....

5. The ambulance driver to us: "Move out of the way!"

6. Daniel to his mother: "Wait for me."

.....

7. Pam to her husband: "Stop acting like a child."

8. Ann to me: "Don't come back late"
