

- These connectors add ideas, items, ...
- The most common of them is 'and'

She's nice **and** clever

Furthermore,... = In addition,... = Plus,... = Besides,... = Moreover

Example: The internet helps people to connect with friends and family, and it is also cheap.
Furthermore,
She's nice and clever. **Plus**, she's the best of friends.

What's more,...

1. **Used to express addition for the last element.**
2. **It reinforces the importance of such last element**

Example: Pet pigs are cleaner than dogs. **Besides**, they do not eat much. **Furthermore**, they make wonderful walking buddies. **What's more**, they are fantastic guards. All are advantages!
She's nice and clever. **Plus**, she's the best of friends. **What's more**, she lives in a wonderful house by the beach.

Also,...

1. **Placed at the beginning of the sentence or before the verb (except for 'to be')**

Examples: She is nice and clever. **Also**, she's good at sports.
= She's nice and clever, She's **also** good at sports
I love Massive Attack. My brother **also** loves them.

Too = as well

1. **Placed at the end of the sentence.**

Examples: I like pop music; I love rock, **too** / **as well**

As well as

Examples: **As well as** pop music, I love rock
= I love pop music **as well as** rock
