Animal: A koala
Lives: Australia
Sleeps: in the top of eucalyptus during the day
Eats: leaves of eucalyptus
It has: small eyes, big ears, big black nose, two hands, two legs, thick grey fur, small pouch and sharp claws
Can: climb the trees, swim
Height: about 75 cm
Weight: 5-14 Kg
Duration of life: 12-20 years



Animal: A rhino
Lives: Africa
Sleeps: at night
Eats: grass
It has: long face, small eyes, small ears, two horns, four legs, small tail
Can: run fast (55 km/hour)
Height: up to 1.7 meters
Weight: up to 800-2000 Kg
Likes: lie in the mud
Duration of life: 30-45 years



Animal: A hippopotamus
Lives: Africa, near water
Sleeps: in water during the day
Eats: grass
It has: small eyes, small ears, big mouth, four legs, and small tail
Can: submerge into water
Height: about 1.65 meters
Weight: up to 4500 Kg
Duration of life: up to 40 years
