essay (n) /'eseɪ/	a piece of writing written by students to answer a question or explain an idea	You need to finish your essay before school.
project (n) /'prɒdʒekt/	a study of a subject at school that a student needs to do over time	My class is working on a project on American short stories.
homework (n) /'həʊmwɜ:k/	work that the teacher gives to the student to do at home	Mr. Bill always gives us lots of homework to do.
book report (n phr.) /bʊk rɪ'pɔ:rt/	a book description written by students after they have finished reading it	In our literature class, we learn how to write a book report .
test (n) /test/	a set of questions or exercises used in school to assess a student's ability or skill	She is studying for her final math test .
presentation (n) /ˌpri:zn'teɪʃn/	a talk that students give at school in front of other people	My group gives a presentation on history this Friday.

Grammar

Have to

We use **have to** + **infinitive without to** to say it is important or necessary for somebody to do something.

Affirmative

I/You/We/They **have to** do homework.
She/he **has to** do homework.

Negative

I/You/We/They **don't have to** do a test.
She/he **doesn't have to** do homework.

Questions

Do we/you/they **have to** do your homework?
Yes, we/I/they **do**. / No, we/I/they **don't**.
Does he/she **have to** work on a project?
Yes, he/she **does**. / No, he/she **doesn't**.
