We can use <u>and</u> and <u>but</u> to join two short sentences to make one longer sentence.

The conjunction and joins sentences with similar ideas.

My sister had a birthday. She got a new bike. My sister had a birthday and she got a new bike. The conjunction but joins sentences with different ideas.

My aunt lives far away.

She calls me often.

My aunt lives far away but she calls me often.
