Punctuation Marks: The Colon and The Hyphen

The Colon (:) is used for the following:

- ***To introduce a list of items. (We bought the following items: ice, forks and cups)***
- ***To separate hours from minutes when writing the time. (3:15 pm)***
- ***To separate the chapter and verse in a bible text. (John 3:16)***

The Hyphen (-) is used for the following:

- ***With compound numbers. (twenty- five)***
- ***Fractions used as adjectives. (two- thirds)***
- ***Between compound words. (mother-in-law)***
