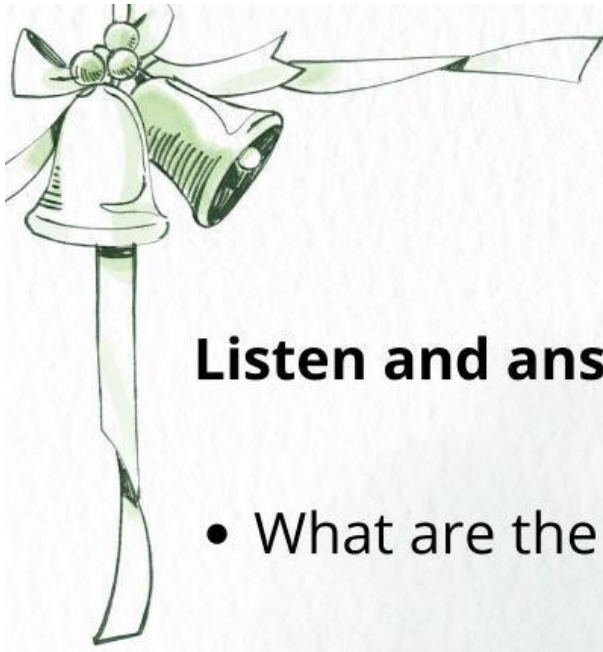

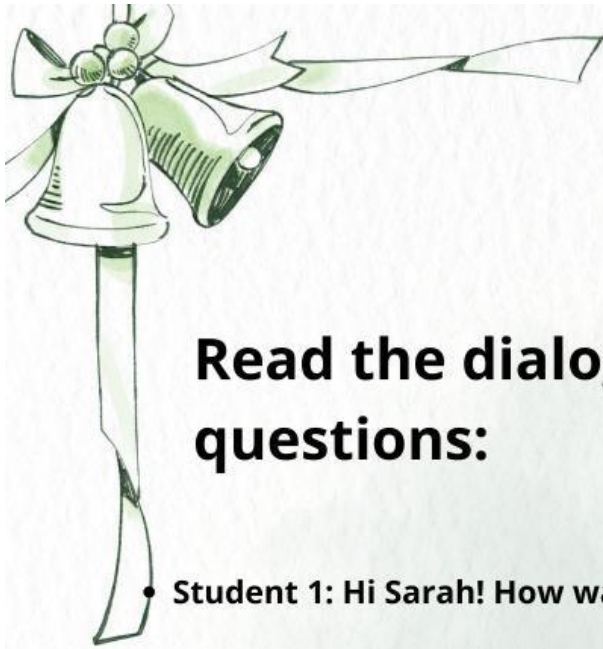

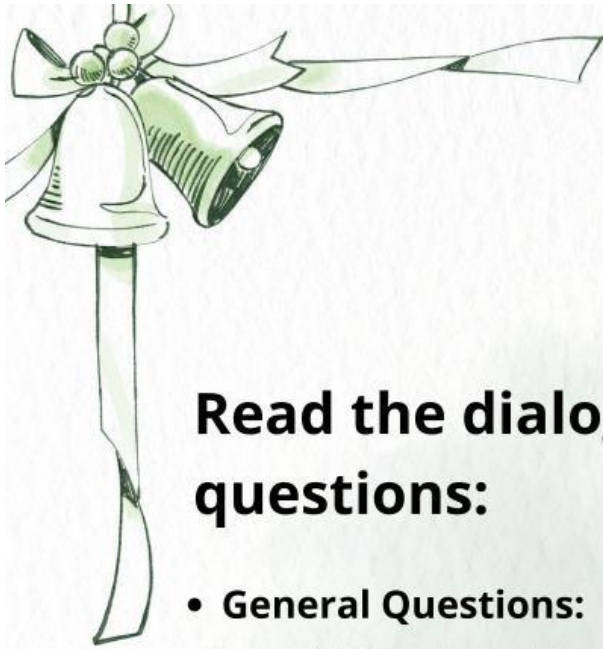




Read the dialogue and answer the questions:

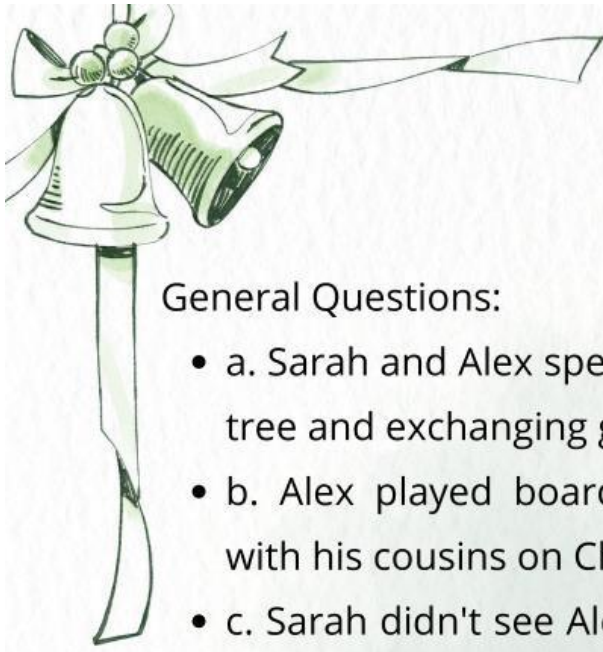

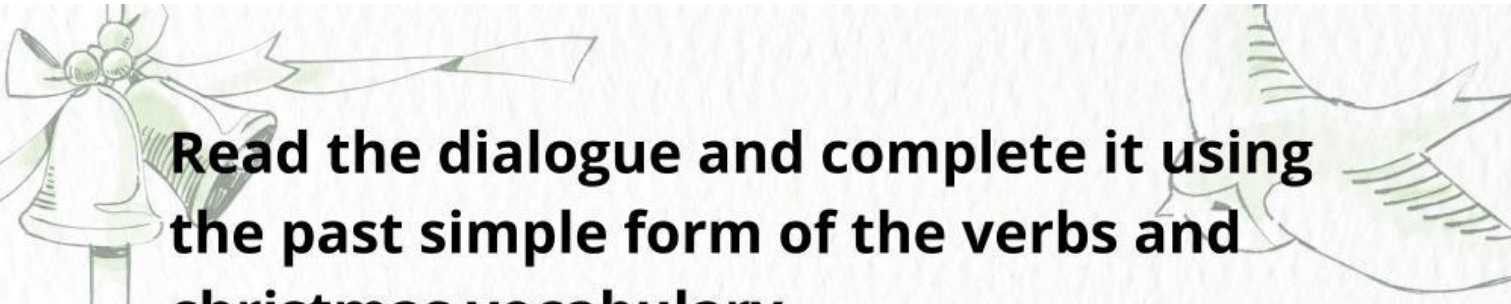
Present Simple Questions:

- d. They built a snowman in the garden because of the snow.

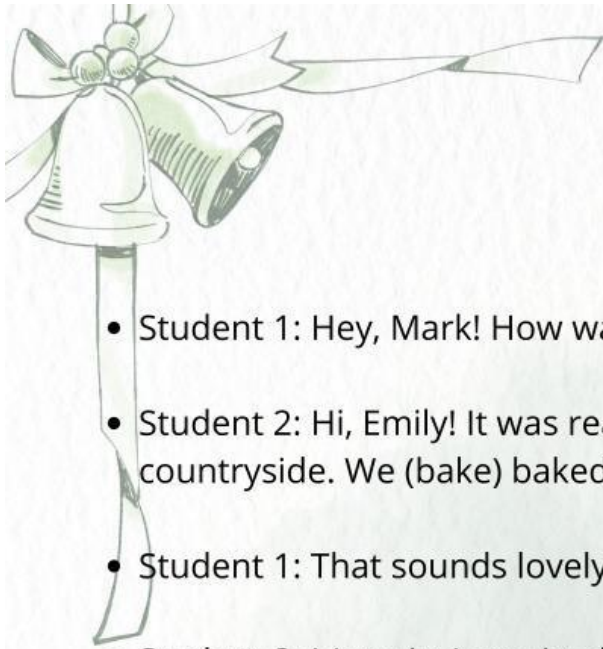
