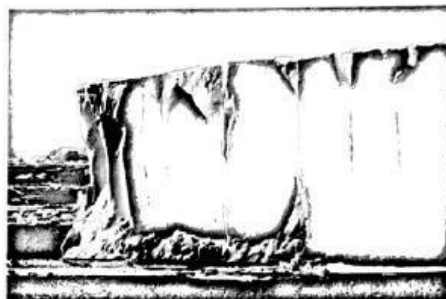

Antarctica – some interesting facts

- the windiest place on Earth: winds can reach 320 km/h
- the driest place on Earth (The Dry Valleys of Antarctica); low humidity, no snow or ice
- the highest point: 4,987 m
- Mount Erebus: the southernmost active volcano on Earth



Tekst 2

Roald Amundsen was a Norwegian explorer and a member of a team who went to Antarctica – the coldest place on Earth. In 1911, his expedition built a base camp on the ice and, to begin with, made several 20 km trips to try out their dogs and equipment. The extreme conditions and lack of sleep made them exhausted, but on 14th December 1911 they managed to plant the Norwegian flag at the South Pole. It was the first ever expedition to successfully reach the South Pole.
