### Present Simple

VS

### Present Progressive

#### Example:

I learn English everyday.

I am learning English now.

#### Use:

Something happens **in general**.

Something is happening **right now** or  
in the **near future**.

#### Signal words:

every.../ often / normally / always...etc

at the moment / now / today / right  
now

#### Form:



(I, You, We, They)  learn English everyday.  
(He, She, It) learns English everyday.

I am learning English now.

(He, She, It) is learning English now.

(You, We, They) are learning English now.



(I, You, We, They) **don't** learn English everyday.  
(He, She, It) **doesn't** learn English everyday.

I am not learning English now.

(He, She, It) is not learning English now.

(You, We, They) are not learning English now.



Do (I, You, We, They) learn English everyday?  
Does (He, She, It) learn English everyday?

Am I learning English now?

Is (He, She, It) learning English now?

Are (You, We, They) learning English now?
