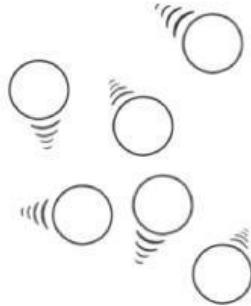

Matter is Made up of Particles,

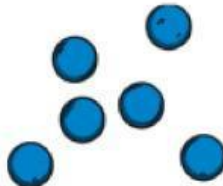
How do solids, Liquids and Gases Behave?
