Sharjah International Book Fair (SIBF) is an 11-day international book fair held annually in Sharjah, United Arab Emirates. It is one of the world's largest book fairs, and it has over 400 literary events. The book fair debuted in 1982 under the guidance and patronage of Sheikh Sultan Bin Muhammad Al-Qasimi, the UAE Supreme Council Member and Ruler of Sharjah. (SIBF) hosts a number of diverse events every year, catering to people with all kinds of interests. Every year, the book fair hosts a number of book signings. In 2023, under the theme of 'We Speak Books,' the fair brought around 600 authors from all over the world to sign their new books. In 2023, its latest edition, the book fair organized 60 workshops. These workshops cover different topics, from art to calligraphy to technology also the fair hosted 130 theatrical performances, including an Emirati-made play titled 'Barcode Prison.' The book fair honours winners of different types of competitions based on different topics and themes, and they include the following: Best Emirati Novel, Best Emirati Academic Book, Best Emirati Creative Literature Book, Best Emirati First Novel Book Award, Best Arabic Novel, Best International Fiction Book, Best International Non-Fiction Book and Sharjah Publisher Recognition Awards. These awards are honoured by Sheikha Bodour Bint Sultan Al Qasimi, the Chairperson of the Sharjah Book Authority (SBA).
