


FEMALE REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

Label the parts of the female reproductive system in the picture.



Match the parts of the female reproductive system with its functions.

Ovaries

Connect the ovaries to the uterus. The egg travels down the fallopian tubes to the uterus.

Uterus

It is a strong, stretchy passage that connects the vulva to the cervix.

Fallopian tubes

It grows a thick lining each month to prepare for a possible pregnancy. If there is no pregnancy, then the uterus sheds its lining. This is called a **menstrual period**.

Vagina

Function production of eggs (carry genetic information) they produce hormones for the correct functioning of the reproductive organs.
