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Public Speaking Tips

Do you have to speak in public – in English?! If so, here are some tips to help you.

- ¹ down ideas in your first language on a piece of paper. If you don't know how to say any of the words on your piece of paper in English, use a bilingual dictionary to ² each word and find a good ³
- Write the speech in English. Before writing, you may have to ⁴ some useful phrases that we use in a speech in your English book. Once you have studied the phrases again, use them in your speech.
- After writing the speech, read it carefully and ⁵ the spelling and grammar. Make sure there are no mistakes.
- It is a good idea to ask an English-speaking friend to read your speech aloud while you ⁶ what they say on your phone. You can then play it and listen to it. You could play parts of the speech and ⁷ each part three or four times. This will improve your pronunciation.
- Remember that ⁸ makes perfect, so stand in front of the mirror or in front of friends, and read your speech aloud many times before you have to make the speech for real.
