Subject	+ verb to be (conjugated)	+ verb - ing	+ complements
They	are	visiting	Spain
Susan	is	listening	to music

She      is      reading      a book  
 Subject      V.to be      V. read-ing      complements

We use the present continuous for things that are happening at the moment of speaking.

We can use words like:

- Now
- At the moment
- Right now

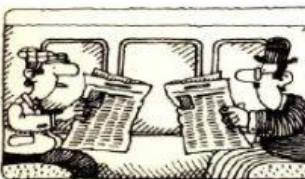
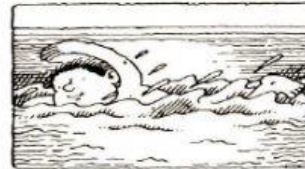
