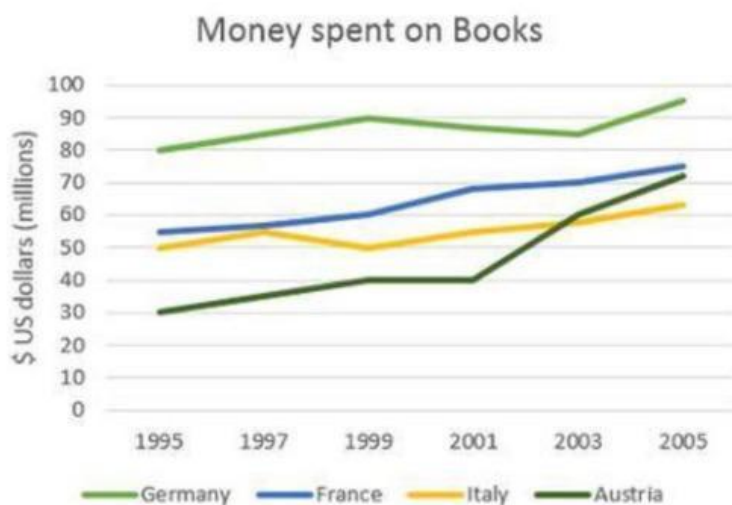


The graph shows the amount of money spent on books in Germany, France, Italy and Austria between 1995 and 2005.



Fixing mistakes

The line graph provides info on the trend in **percentage** of millions of dollars that were spent on books **with** four various countries over a 10-year period.

It is clear that the total money spent on books has increased in each country for the period shown. Overall, it is noticeable that **the exhausted million dollars** on books in **Germany and France** rose quickly while that **in Austria and Italy** grew slowly.

In 1995, the **amount spent** on books in Germany was about 80 million dollars. In France, its number is about over 50 million dollars. The **number of** money on books in Italy and Austria **were** lower, at about **50 and 30** respectively.

In the next ten years, great changes occurred. **The money spent on books** witnessed a considerable increase from 80 in 1995 to over 90 in 2005. France showed a gradual growth in the **number of money using it** from approximately 55 to over 70 during the examined years. In Italy, the number slowly went up by 15 million dollars in 2005. **Following the same trend, there was a significant growth of 35 million dollars in Austria.**
