Kelly : Yes, I am. Let's go somewhere else. I am thirsty.


10 **Narrator:** They fly and fly to look for water. Kelly is unhappy.

Kelly : Yes, I am very tired ... and thirsty ... and hungry.


15 **Narrator:** Ken sees a pond.


