___ **AFTER THAT**, STRAIN THE BLENDED MIX.

___ **FINALLY**, SERVE AND ENJOY IT!

___ **THEN**, MIX THE STRAINED BERRY OAT MIXTURE WITH THE NARANJILLA JUICE MIX, RETURN TO HEAT AND BRING TO A BOIL, REDUCE THE HEAT AND COOK OVER

___ **NEXT**, BLEND THE BERRIES, THE SOAKED OATS AND TWO CUPS OF NARANJILLA MIX
